REQUEST for PROPOSALS

FURNISHING AND INSTALLING THREE (3) EMERGENCY GENERATORS

BID NO EP16/17 - 6

The City of East Providence is seeking bid proposals from companies to furnish and install emergency generators at the following municipal facilities:

- East Providence City Hall located at 145 Taunton Avenue
- East Providence Public Works Facility located at 60 Commercial Way
- East Providence Senior Center located at 610 Waterman Avenue.

It is the intent of the City to remove the existing generators and furnish and install emergency standby power generator sets along with transfer switches and all required electrical connections in accordance with these specifications and all applicable State and Local requirements.

FOUR WRITTEN SEALED PROPOSALS shall be submitted to the Office of the City Manager, City Hall, Room 102, 145 Taunton Avenue, East Providence, RI 02914-4505 **until 2:00 PM, Tuesday, February 14, 2017** at which time said bids will be publicly opened. Date/time stamps of 2:01 or later will be rejected. Mark on outside bid envelope the bid title, bid number and date/time of bid opening.

A pre-bid conference will be held at **10:00 am on Wednesday, February 1, 2017**. The location will be Conference Room A, City Hall 145 Taunton Avenue, East Providence, RI 02914.

Specifications may be obtained at the Office of the Purchasing Agent, City Hall, Room 206, 145 Taunton Ave., East Providence, RI, Monday through Friday 8am to 4pm or downloaded from the City website at "www.eastprovidenceri.net" under Bid Information.

Bid security in the amount of 5% of the total amount bid must accompany all bids.

Performance, Labor & Material Payment Bonds, in the amount of 100% of the contract price will be required of the successful bidder.

Attention of bidders is called to the provisions of Title 37, Chapter 13, General Laws of Rhode Island, as amended 1984 Reenactment. Particular attention is called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and prevailing wage rates to be paid under the contract.

The minimum rates to be paid labor of the various classifications shall be in accordance with the current schedule of Wages established by the State Labor Commissioner as provided in the RI Decisions as revised.
