Introduction

The City of East Providence is seeking a firm to furnish and install four (4) TrueBounce basketball goals and a Smart Play 205160 Cube manufactured by Landscape Structure for the Onna Moniz-John Neighborhood Park/Central Avenue Playground. The site is a City owned 2.39 acre park with existing amenities that include a basketball court, swing sets, a play structure, a pavilion, park benches, picnic tables, walking paths, a lawn and mature trees. The park is located in a dense residential neighborhood of the City with frontage on Central Avenue, McCausland Avenue and John Street.

Furnish and Install

1. Four (4) TrueBounce or approved equal 42" x 72" clear polycarbonate perforated outdoor backboards with goals and nets with retrofit kit for a gooseneck pole;
2. Smart Play 205160 Cube manufactured by Landscape Structure or approved equal. The play structure will be installed in an existing 40' X 40' play area that previously had a play structure that was removed several years ago. The play area currently has sand at a depth of 1 feet with a gravel sub base. The City will remove the existing sand and replace with engineered wood fiber.

Timeline

All of the items must be furnished and installed by June 10, 2016.

Fee Proposals

A fee proposal shall be submitted to the Office of the City Manager, 145 Taunton Avenue, East Providence, RI 02914 no later than 2:00 PM on Wednesday, April 13, 2016. Responses to this fee proposal shall include the following information:

1. Name of Firm.
2. Business address, including city, state, zip code and phone/fax number.
3. Indicate whether or not incorporated. If so, when?
4. If not incorporated, name of owner(s).
5. Have you ever defaulted on a contract? If so, where and why?
6. Description of the background and relevant experience of the firm to be responsible for the scope of services outlined above, along with any sub-consultants to be employed.
7. A time schedule for installing and furnishing the above items. All of the items must be furnished and installed by June 10, 2016.

8. A separate fee for each of the above items. As a result of budget constraints, the City may decide to purchase one or two of the items.

General Conditions

- The City reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, to waive any informality, and to select and negotiate services in the best interest of the City;
- The firm will abide by all Federal, State and City regulations;
- The City reserves the right to accept all or part of any proposal, and to negotiate a contract for services and cost with the selected firm;
- The Firm will abide by HUD regulations including but not limited to Section 3 and applying David Bacon prevailing wage rates to all construction laborers. (Please find attached General Decision Number RI 160001 dated 03/11/2016, the Federal Labor Standards Provisions, Appendix II to Part 200 - Contract Provisions for Non-Federal Entity Contracts under Federal Awards, Subpart B - Economic Opportunities for Section 3 Residents and Section 3 Business Concerns and Form HUD 60002);
