**TECHNICAL and INSPECTION SERVICES for the
KENT HEIGHTS WATER STORAGE TANK**

This RFP is a reissuance of RFP#EP1516-20 which was issued May 19, 2016. Only one bid was received and opened on June 08, 2016. The City of East Providence hereafter called the “Owner” will receive sealed bids for Technical and Inspection Services for the Kent Heights Water Storage Tank, East Providence, RI as outlined in the specifications.

Copies of bidding documents and performance specifications can be downloaded from the City’s website at www.eastprovidenceri.com under **Bid Information**.

Sealed bids will be received in the office of the City Manager, Room 102, City Hall, 145 Taunton Avenue, East Providence, RI 02914 until 2:00 PM on Wednesday, July 13, 2016. The bids will be publicly opened at that time. Bids stamped with a time of 2:01 PM or later will be rejected.

Bidders must provide **FOUR** copies of their proposals submitted in sealed envelopes **marked with RFP BID EP15/16 – 20R and “Technical and Inspection services for the Kent Heights Water Storage Tank” on the outside.**

Fundamental Components of the project:

- Furnish all labor, materials and incidental items necessary to complete this project.
- Furnish, inspect, provide technical information and complete project.

The specific scope of services will be detailed in the bid request, and the final award will be based on the lowest qualified evaluated bid price. A team of city staff will review responses to the RFP. The following criteria will be used to evaluate the responses:

- Adequate staffing and the expertise to complete the project successfully.
- Financial and Performance and Payment bonding for 100% of the Bid price of this project.
- Proven ability to work with municipal governments and to complete similar projects on time and within budget.
